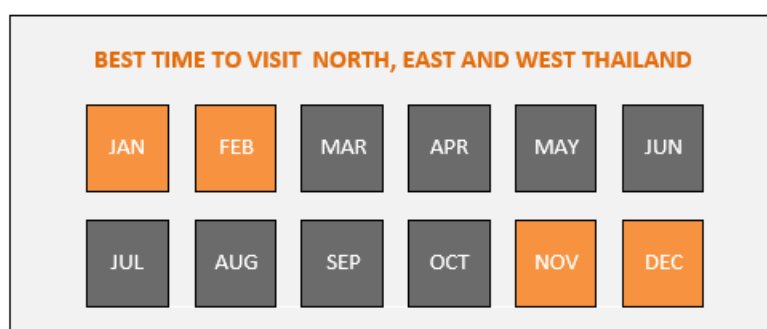


CLIMATE & TIMES TO VISIT

Thailand has a tropical climate with three distinct seasons. The weather is hot and dry from **February to May** with the average temperature about 34 degrees Celsius and 75% humidity. The rainy season starts from **June to October** with plenty of sunshine and the average day temperature is about 29 degrees Celsius and 87% humidity. From **November to January** is the period of winter with temperatures ranging from 32 degrees Celsius to below 20 degrees Celsius and with a drop in humidity. Much lower temperature are experienced in the North and Northeast during nighttime.



In generally, Thailand's climate is hot, humid and (like other South-East Asian countries) monsoonal. The seasons differ from coast to coast, so depending on which areas you're visiting, the weather can vary. Thailand's north, east and west are great to visit from **November to February** when the weather is dry

and the temperatures are not too hot. The southern part of Thailand however does not have a winter. So it's possible to enjoy Thailand's beaches year-round.
